## Sample Produce for 2011 (May - November)

Weather, pests, and disease affect the harvest, but the farmers will provide variety and value to the best of their ability. The most perishable items are picked on delivery day. **Spring:** beets with greens, broccoli, cauliflower, hothouse cucumbers, lettuce, green onions, sugar snap peas, new potatoes, radishes, spinach, strawberries, hothouse tomatoes. **Summer:** beans, cabbage, corn, cucumbers, eggplant, garlic, herbs, lettuce, melons, onions, peppers, potatoes, raspberries, squash, tomatoes, heirloom tomatoes. **Fall:** beans, beets, broccoli, Chinese cabbage, carrots, cauliflower, kale, lettuce, onions, sweet potatoes, winter squash, tomatoes, and turnips.
